
OUR VALUES



Child, Youth and Family Programs Open to Self-Referral

Eating Disorders Program (EDP)

This program provides clinical counselling services for children/youth ages 6— 18 and their families affected by disordered eating.

Sexual Abuse Intervention Program (SAIP)

This program provides clinical counselling services for children/youth ages 5 – 18 and their families when sexual abuse has been disclosed. This includes children who are at risk for sexual exploitation or for children under 12 who display inappropriate sexual behaviors.

Living in Families with Teens (LIFT)

This program supports parents/caregivers of youth ages I2– I8 to connect with their teens.

Transitions Program

This program supports youth ages 12—19 involved with substance use with skills-based groups and specialized withdrawal management and supportive recovery services.

Child, Youth and Family Programs Requiring MCFD Referral

Mental Health Outreach (MHO)

This program supports children/youth ages 6-18 and their parent/caregivers through outreach and counseling activities that promote healthy functioning within the home and community. All referrals come from Child and Youth Mental Health.

Youth Services Program (YSP)

This program supports at-risk youth ages 12 – 18 involved with MCFD, to connect to community resources and achieve personal goals. All referrals come from a social worker on the Youth Team.

Domestic Violence Response Program (DVRP)

This program provides service directly to the male partner of a parenting couple involved in domestic violence where MCFD is connected. Referral through Ministry for Children and Family Development: 250 741-5444.
